### Car Access Routes

#### From Tomei Expressway/Route 255

Get off the Tomei Expressway at Oi-Matsuda IC in the direction of Yamakita, bearing right, and merge into Route 255. At the end take a right to Route 246 and go straight. Then take a right at 「寄入口」 Yadoriki Iriguchi and follow the road for about 15 minutes.

#### From Hadano/Atsugi

On Route 246, take a right at 「寄入口」 Yadoriki Iriguchi and follow the road for about 15 minutes.

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## Hiking

### Mt. Take Old Road Hiking Course

Time 3 hrs 30 mins (excl break) Distance 10.3km

Access Fujikyū Shonan bus to 「寄」 Yadoriki, get off at 「田代向」 Tashiromukai after about 18 mins.

Back when most houses had thatched roofs, Mt. Take was a bustling place for people collecting thatch materials. Currently the course is having a resurgence as an easy hiking trail suited for beginners.



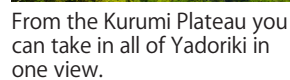
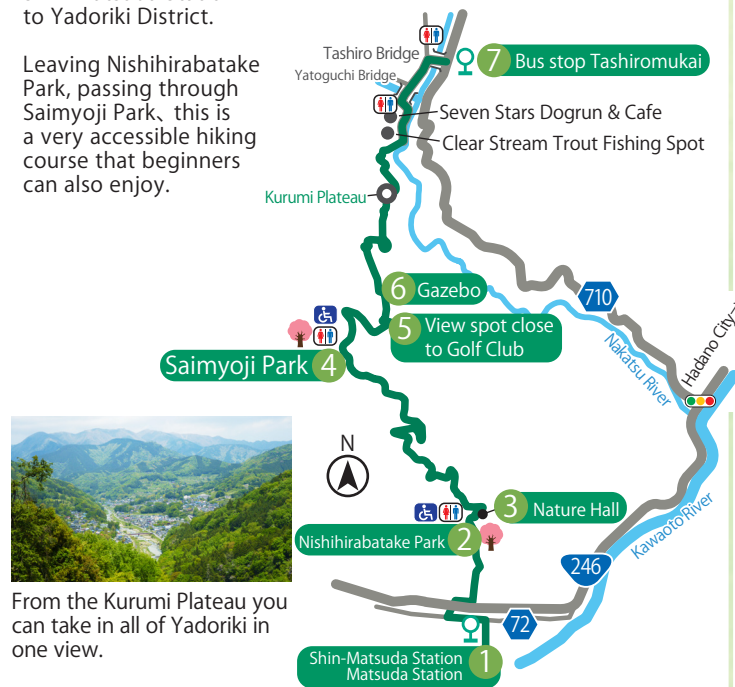
### Mt. Matsuda Green Wind Nature Trail

Time 4 hrs (excl break) Distance 8.4km

Access Odakyu Line 「Shin-Matsuda Station」  
JR Gotemba Line 「Matsuda Station」

This course leads from Shin-Matsuda Station to Yadoriki District.

Leaving Nishihibatabake Park, passing through Saimyoji Park, this is a very accessible hiking course that beginners can also enjoy.



From the Kurumi Plateau you can take in all of Yadoriki in one view.

### Mt. Takamatsu & Hanajoro Way Mushizawa Old Road Course

Time 4 hrs (excl break) Distance 10km

Access Fujikyū Shonan bus to 「寄」 Yadoriki, get off at 「田代向」 Tashiromukai after about 18 mins.

Until the late Meiji era the Mushizawa district was connected to Yamakita Town's 8th district with a lively road, where a lot of brides (hanayome) also passed through, which led to the name Hanajoro Way.



At the entrance hangs a temple bell.



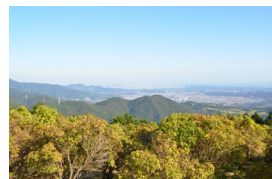
From the top of Mt. Takamatsu a wide view of Mt. Fuji and the Ashigara Plains can be enjoyed.

### Mt. Shidango • Mt. Miyaji Hiking Course

Time 3 hrs 10 mins (excl break) Distance 6.5km

Access Fujikyū Shonan bus to 「寄」 Yadoriki, get off at 「田代向」 Tashiromukai after about 18 mins.

The mountain is named after the legend of a mountain hermit in the Asuka era (538-710) called Shidagon who is said to have established a residence at the top of the mountain and spread Buddhist teachings in the area. 'Shidagon' eventually became Shidango.



When reaching the top of Mt. Shidango, a 360 degree panoramic view opens up.

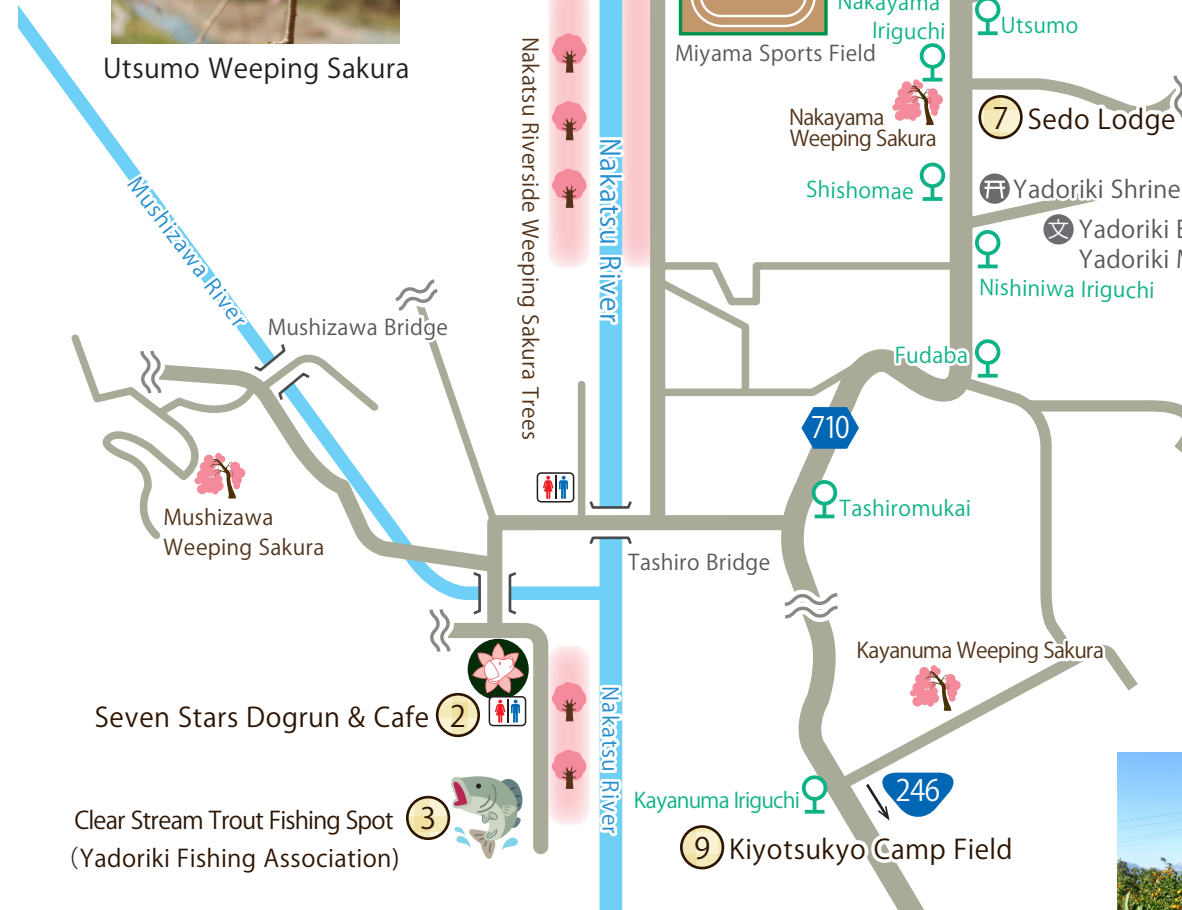

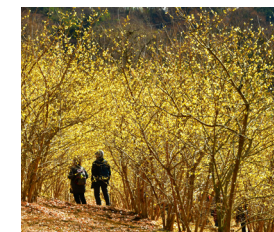
