



This procession is the reproduction of a ritual depicted in a well-known historical scroll from Edo Period Odawara. It is counted among the "50 Kanagawa Folk Performing Arts" and is an "intangible cultural property" of the town.



Hyakuhatte

Long ago, during the fall of Matsuda Castle, farmers lit bonfires to guide fleeing warriors to safety. The fires are also said to be prayers for a rich harvest.

Ashigara Fireworks Festival

The festival is organized by the towns of Matsuda and Kaisei. The fireworks will set the night sky on fire, illuminating the riverbed area.
